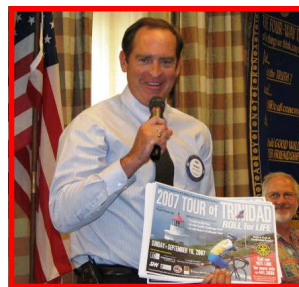

'Cause I'm the Taxman,

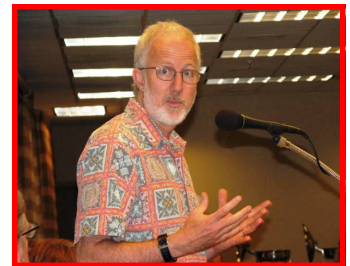
